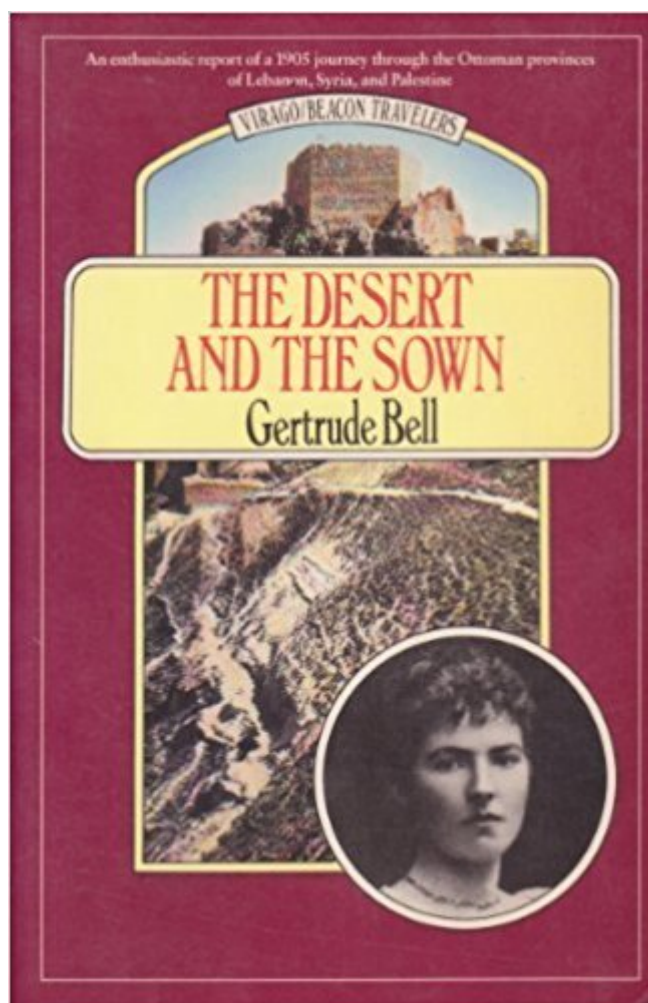


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The Desert And The Sown (Virago/Beacon Travelers)
