

History comes alive through the eyes and lives of several major characters. I found myself needing to know what would happen next to sweet, selfless Hadassah, and her Roman masters, the Valerians. Strong personalities came alive as characters are extremely well developed in this story. This first book in the Mark of the Lion series is at times graphic and violent.
