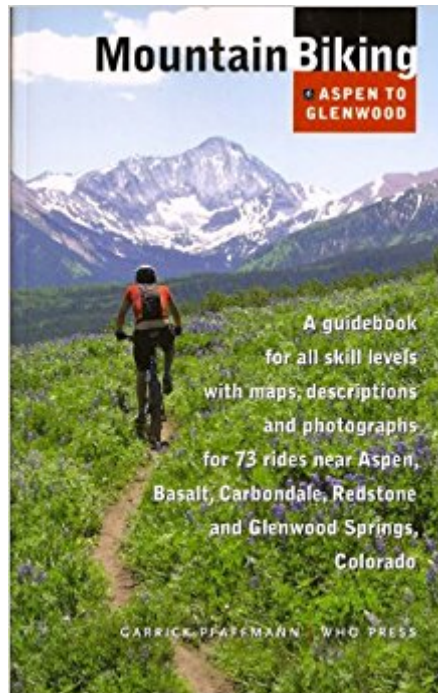


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Mountain Biking: Aspen To Glenwood



Synopsis

The Roaring Fork, Frying Pan and Crystal River valleys and the surrounding mountains in Central Colorado near Aspen and Glenwood Springs offer an expansive network of roads and trails for biking with scenery which draws visitors from all over the world. The 73 rides in this book cover a wide spectrum of terrain and difficulty from the valley-long paved Rio Grande Trail to Snowmass single tracks, one of which is appropriately named Anaerobic Nightmare. The routes which travel on single tracks, jeep trails and paved roads, give visitors and locals alike a variety of opportunities to explore this scenic wonderland by bike, and to prepare for future adventures. The book includes road and trail rides, 19 detailed maps and 48 route photographs.
