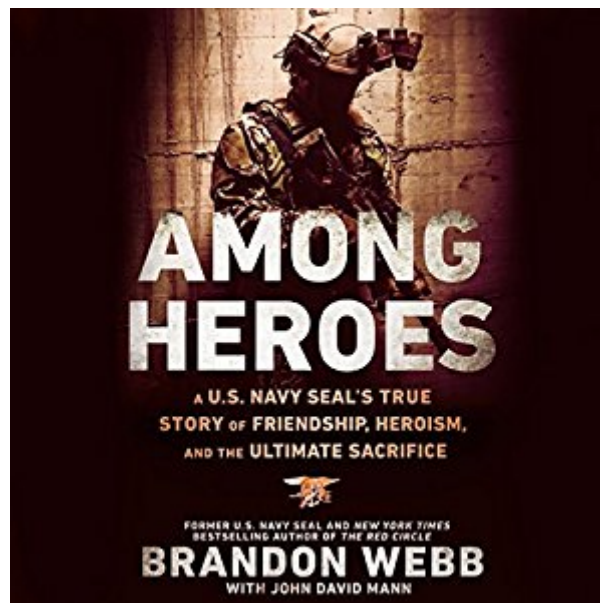

Of Glen Doherty, Webb's best friend for more than a decade, killed while helping secure the successful rescue and extraction of American CIA and State Department diplomats in Benghazi, Libya, on September 11, 2012; and other close friends, classmates, and fellow warriors.

There are all types of books about different categories. This book was not only about the sacrifices of Navy SEALs and other servicemen and women, but who they are/were as people. Thank you to the author Brandon Webb for sharing your story about your team members and family. Fewer than 1% of our population ever serve our Great Nation. There are far fewer percentage that ever make it to our elite Special Forces. Although the author couldn't possibly have enough pages/time to write about everyone he has served with, he has honored those he did write about. The men and women of our military are not just a name on a page or a story in a headline. They are sons, daughters, husbands, wives, mothers, fathers, uncles, aunts. Most of all they are people brave enough to raise their right hand and sign a contract to protect all of us from both foreign and domestic enemies. The numbers of killed in action or wounded in action can easily be found. However, those "numbers" each have a story of loss with them. They each have a story and a sacrifice. All those people willingly raised their hand and signed a contract that includes up to their life. The family and friends that mourn their loss or are there to take care of those injured would benefit from this book. It shows who the people were and the lessons they taught along the way. It reminds it is of course ok to be sad of their death. At the same time be ok with it as they were doing what they loved and to protect as many as they can. Part of the Army's Soldier's Creed is "I am a guardian of freedom and the American way of life." Every branch of our Military has a similar version. Among Heroes is a very straight-forward, quick and enjoyable read about a guy's personal recollections on close friendships lost to war/mortality since 9/11. This is not "another SEAL book". There aren't war stories in this book. It's about the interaction with the person and what made them memorable and worthy of a tribute like this. By no means did any of the men talked about live a normal or boring life, they were amazing people...larger than life, but they were human. Brandon also hits on situations/stories that are less than flattering which may come to the reader's surprise. Overall, you can tell a completely honest portrait is painted of these men...and it in no way falls short of awe and reverence.

This is a great read for those who want to learn more about the Elite Warriors that keep us safe. Having read a number of books dealing with the WOT, some of the "Heroes" were known, but Brandon Webb did a great job of bringing a new perspective to them.

The book was well written. He described the unique character of each individual and the inspirational attributes which made them "heroes". I sensed, at times, the emotional pain of how each one touched his life in profound ways. This gives insight to the reader on a personal level. I enjoy Webb's honest description of the characters and the lessons and life experiences they shared, the memories to last a lifetime.
