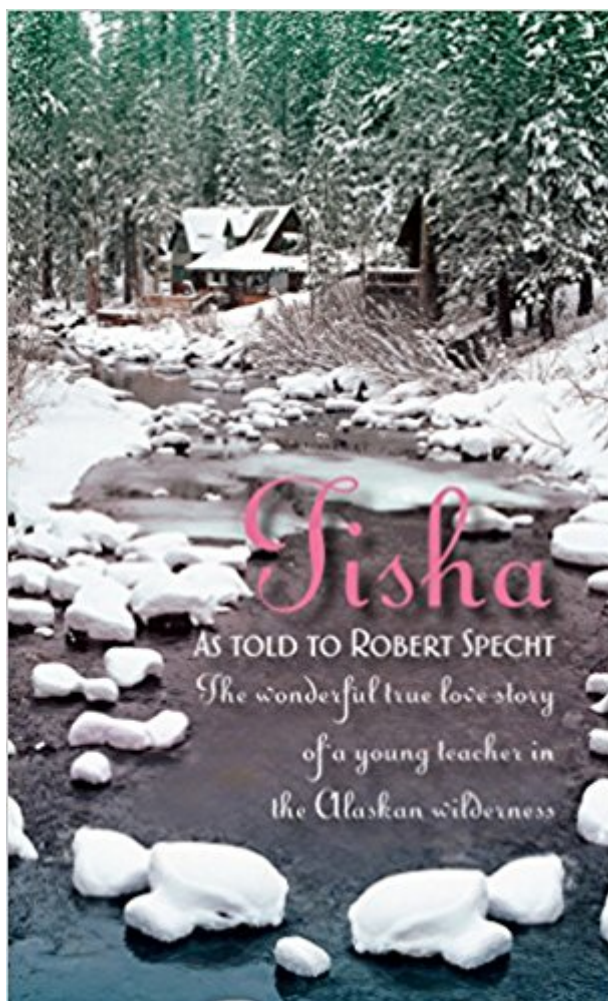

This is a story of a young naive schoolteacher who moves up to Chicken, Alaska and the book

chronicles her school year up there. It was a fascinating read and I found it intriguing, but sad, how the Native American populations and the white settlers interacted. "Tisha" definitely pokes a stick in the wasp's nest with how she flaunts Alaskan societal norms. What I was disappointed in is the cutoff of the story. How did her next teaching job go? Did she stay in contact with all or some of the people she had formed attachments to in Chicken? Or did she make a completely clean break?

I learned more about the Native American culture by reading this book, than living 55 years near a Native American reservation. Anne was so young when she set out to teach in the wilderness, yet she had sound values and remained steadfast to what she knew was right. If I could give this book 8 stars I would. Well written, informative, and it touched my heart. Whenever I read a book and I continue to think about it, even weeks later, then for sure it's a good book!

I don't know much about Alaska but what a great story of a heroine. Annie was so young when she went there but matured so fast with the trials she went through. It was interesting to hear about the prejudices there and it was sad she had to wait so long to marry the man she loved. Would love to see this as a movie. So glad I read it.

Just an awesome account of life in early 1900's Alaska written from the perspective of someone who faced life and its challenges with boldness and didn't back down or give up when confronted with extreme difficulties, whether from the weather or people who opposed her ideals. Full of adventure, it will hold your attention to the very end!

As a retired elementary school teacher, I found this book to be fascinating. I learned so
