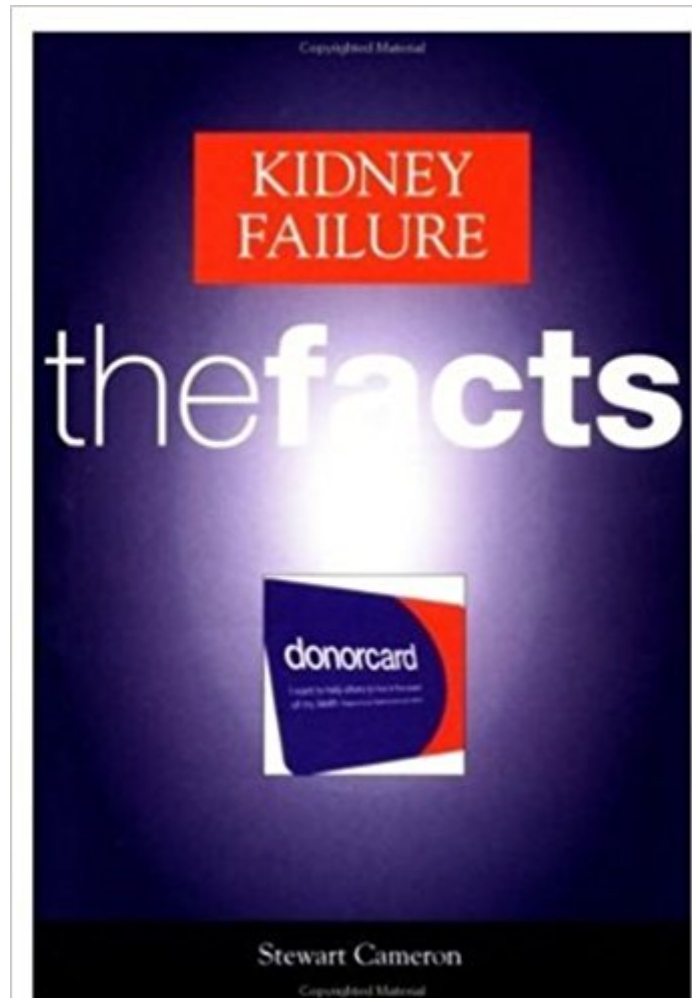

This is the best book on this topic that I have seen. Although it was published in 1966, and last reprinted in 2002, the information is still very valid. It will also arm you with lots of questions for your nephrologist that you might not have thought of. This, along with information available from websites such as ustransplant.org, will well equipment you for the future.
