

The author was born in Pau, France. He was raised in both San Francisco and Santa Cruz, California. Bill has enjoyed surfing, snorkeling, backpacking and museum viewing since he was a teenager. Having completed his Air Force commitment with a tour in Vietnam as an Aerial Reconnaissance Photographer, he graduated from San Francisco State University with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Anthropology (Archaeology) followed by a Teaching Credential. Bill worked as a caretaker at the Calico Early Man Site under the tutelage of Ruth DeEtte Simpson. He also

participated in several projects and field surveys conducted by the Paleontology and Geology Department of the Museum of Northern Arizona with William J. Breed as curator. In the early 1980s, Bill volunteered as a docent, then became a paid staff member at the Ano Nuevo State Reserve, in San Mateo County, California. Bill's love of nature, archaeology and geology, plus his skill as a photographer, brought excitement to the classroom where he taught social studies, science and history classes for over ten years.
