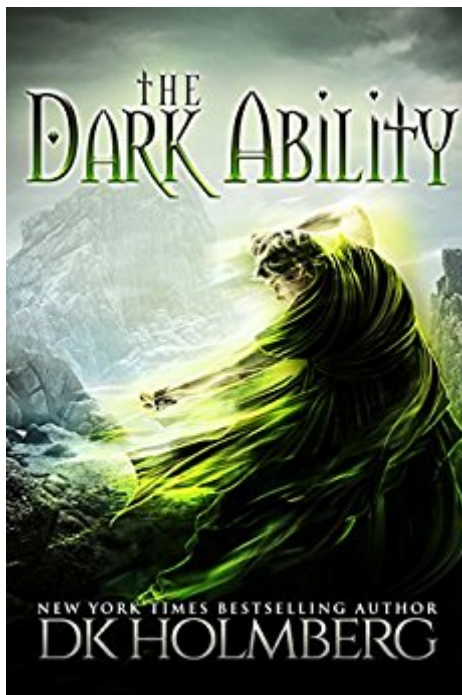


The book was found

This book was pretty good. World building and characters were both solid, though the author really needs to be careful about getting too repetitive. He occasionally gets a little bit stuck on a subject or some minor detail and practically beats us over the head with it. I will still be interested in book two

though. The mystery and political intrigue were nicely done. Safety warning: my biggest issue with this book was some minor language. A certain four-letter-D word was used over a dozen times, and the "w" word was used a couple of times in reference to a woman. Otherwise, the story was pretty clean.

One of the easier ways to lose me as a reader is to create characters described as of at least average intelligence, but when the plot progresses, the author doesn't let the characters solve their problems through obvious applications of creativity and their fantasy-world special abilities.
