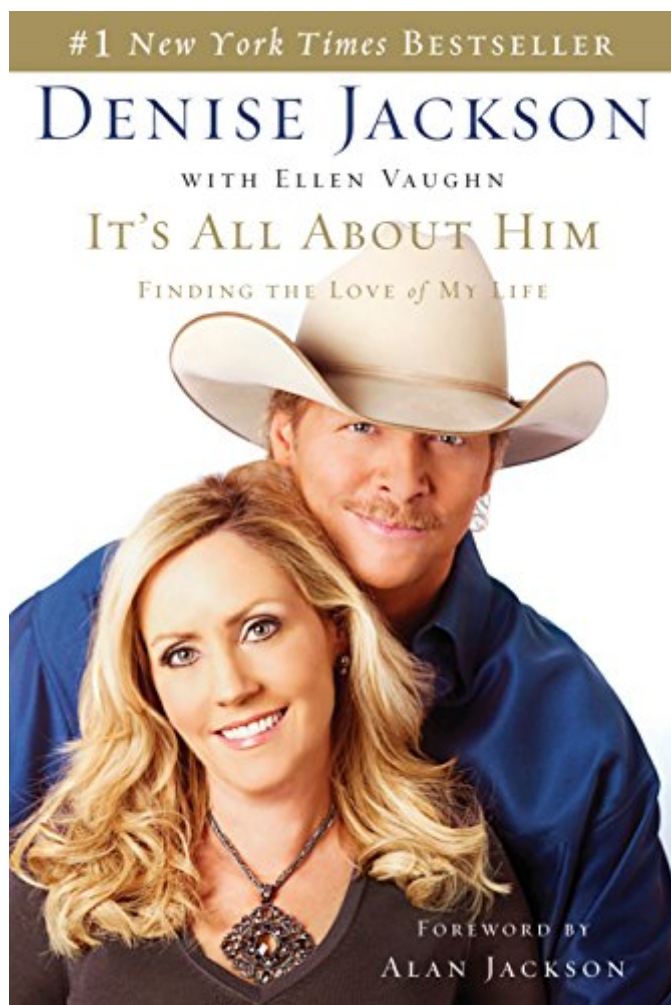


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It's All About Him: Finding The Love Of My Life
