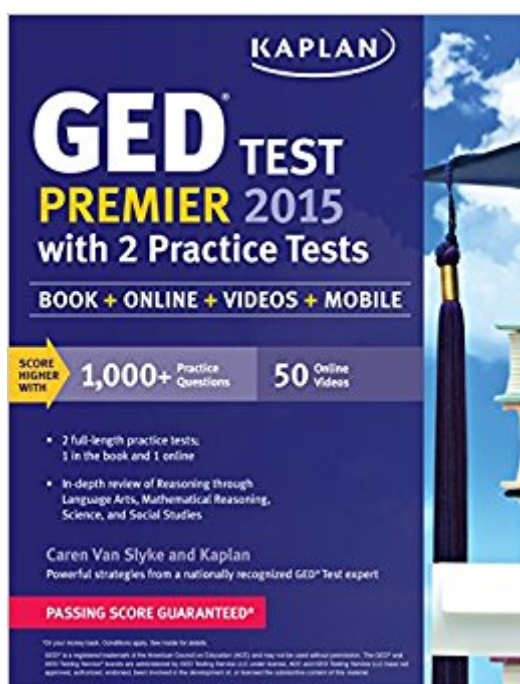

I've taught GED prep classes for many years and consider myself fairly expert on what works and what doesn't. This book is what I call a "big book" of GED material. As a final review and test simulation, it's pretty good, but for most GED students, this book by itself is not enough for thorough test preparation. I always look at the math section of a new GED book first, as math is the most common stumbling block for my students. This book does not provide the step by step explanations and directed practice necessary for thorough understanding and problem solving facility. It is a nice overview and good diagnostic for remedial work, but look elsewhere for the actual explanations and practice. I firmly believe that in all areas except math, GED material can be self taught. This book won't do it all, but it does demonstrate the test format and types of questions and is excellent for practice in answering multiple choice and short answer questions. What I like about this book or, I should say program, are the online support and practice tests. Again, neither will supply remedial instruction, but will indicate where such instruction is needed. No book will ever take the place of a couple of sessions with a good teacher who understands the learning process and can eliminate confusion. Get this book, then, if you're a student who feels ready to take the GED Test. It'll let you know if indeed you are. For the price, it's a bargain. If you aren't ready, start reading everything you can get your hands on, quit texting and start writing, and get yourself enrolled in a GED math class; one in which you can ask questions.

If you don't have a basic understanding of reading, science, math and social studies, I would suggest purchasing foundational books for grade school level to give you a basic understanding before beginning this book.
