

The topics bounce from one to the next like a marble in an arcade game: the author goes from describing companion planting to discussing corn and its many uses to examining how popcorn pops to exploring its historical use at the movies. Through chatty writing, Eliot provides historical details and simple scientific explanations and plies readers with questions, drawing them into the conversation: "Did you knowâ |?" "What's your favoriteâ |?" "Have you everâ |?" This compilation of fun, high-interest facts is matched by busy cartoon art that uses animals in place of humans.
