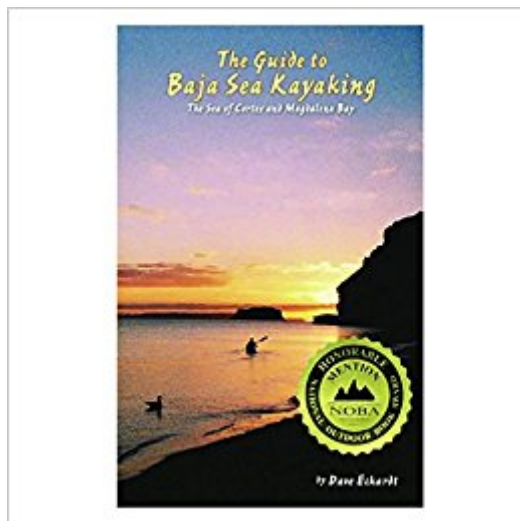

I bought this book after a recent kayaking trip to Baja. I saw a copy of the book at camp on Magdalena Bay run by a tour outfitter. It helped me in writing my travel journal as I didn't know or forgot many of the places we went. I was able to easily retrace our journey using the aerial photographs and maps. It makes me want to plan a trip to Baja again. The author signing a personal copy to me was a bonus.

This is a great book for planning and using on your trip in Baja. I've used it twice, first time on a 10 day trip and for my last solo 21 day trip down the coast and islands. Packed with important info. The binding tends to fall apart but the quality of the info far out weighs this physical flaw.

Although Baja is one of the world's top sea kayaking destinations, there were no decent books on

this subject out there until this one came along. The photos and descriptions provide key information for anyone planning a self-supported trip with recommendations on safe landings, good camp spots and other essential details for an extended kayaking trip to this part of the world.
