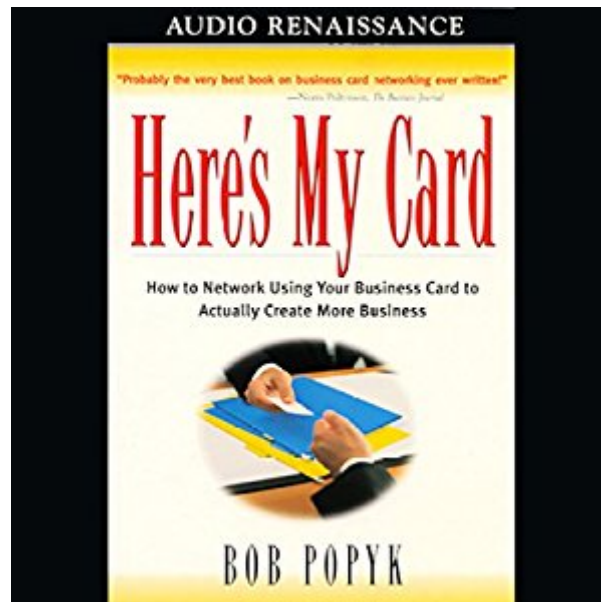




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Here's My Card

In some sense if you read Popyk's columns about selling, you may already know the vast majority of the information in this book: his Acknowledgments section notes that his readers and those who have heard him speak have contributed to the ideas included. The 97 chapters are very short, at times a bit repetitive, and are aimed primarily at people in the various types of sales (whether services or products). One of the main objectives of the book is to provide ideas on how to make you (and your business card) memorable to the people you meet. The second main point is about

follow-up. Most of the remainder of the content is about how to design your own business card. I enjoyed reading this ... folded down a few page corners, and highlighted a few things. So while some of the advice is 'obvious', at least here it's collected all in one place for future reference!
