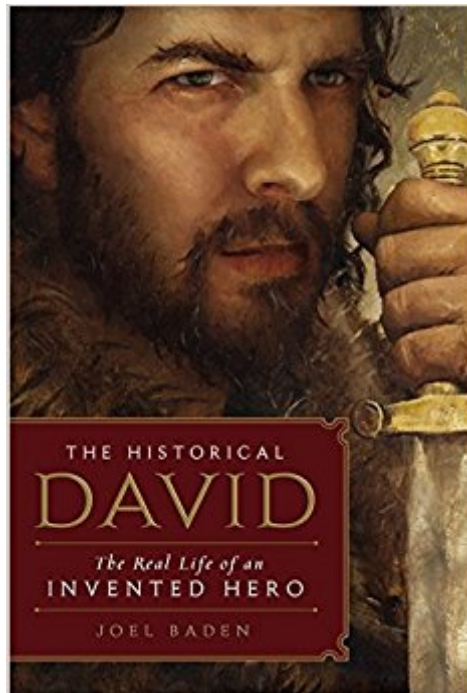




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The Historical David: The Real Life Of An Invented Hero



Synopsis

Joel Baden, a leading expert on the Old Testament, offers a controversial look at the history of King David, the founder of the nation of Israel whose bloodline leads to Jesus, challenging prevailing popular beliefs about his legend in *The Historical David*. Baden makes clear that the biblical account of David is an attempt to shape the events of his life politically and theologically. Going beyond the biblical bias, he explores the events that lie behind the David story, events that are grounded in the context of the ancient Near East and continue to inform modern Israel. *The Historical David* exposes an ambitious, ruthless, flesh-and-blood man who achieved power by any means necessary, including murder, theft, bribery, sex, deceit, and treason. As Baden makes clear, the historical David stands in opposition not only to the virtuous and heroic legends, but to our very own self-definition as David's national and religious descendants. Provocative and enlightening, *The Historical David* provides the lost truth about David and poses a challenge to us: how do we come to terms with the reality of a celebrated hero who was, in fact, similar to the ambitious power-players of his day?

 For all the glory we attribute to David’s legend, the historical reality is both fascinating and disturbing. Through deep textual analysis, Baden brings the historical David vibrantly to life and ultimately reveals that the flesh-and-blood man was far more complex and interesting than the mythical king.

Joel Baden does an excellent job of reading between the lines of the David stories in the Hebrew Bible. Using historical, literary, sociological and psychological insights, he paints a picture of what the historical David might have been like, and how the stories that have come to us in the Bible

should not be read as literal accounts of David's life and activities. Far from the idealized portrait that sees David as an especially courageous, poetic, and righteous model for all to follow, Baden teases out the intrigue, double-dealing, and opportunistic maneuvering of King David. In addition to stripping off the legends and apologetics that have been woven around David in the stories of 1 and 2 Samuel, Baden also argues forcefully for the actual existence of an historical David, noting that if writers had created him out of whole cloth the traces of a different David would not show through the narrative as we have it. Those who consider the Bible to be a perfect source of historical information will not be pleased with this book, but those who are interested in understanding how one goes about detecting historical details behind a sacred story and what one does with what is uncovered will enjoy this book. Baden writes clearly, knows his subject, and offers an unusual perspective on how the royal version of David's rise creates a legendary hero.

As a Presbyterian pastor of long service and the author of *David Lion and Lamb* (available on) I have long been fascinated by King David. Dr. Joel Baden, a Jewish scholar of the Old Testament who teaches at Yale Divinity School has produced a new and controversial book on the shepherd king. Baden states his purpose is to draw a portrait of David in which the mythical and ecclesiastical view of David is scraped clean of centuries of adulation to discover the real man beneath the paint! Among the assertions made by Dr. Baden are: "a. David murdered and manipulated his bloody climb to the kingship of Israel. Along the way he dispensed with Israel's first king and his chief rival King Saul. b. David is important for uniting the twelve tribes of Israel. The ten northern tribes would later break away from Judah following the death of the aged David. c. In a radical view he believes that Solomon was the son of Uriah and not David! d. Whether or not you buy the professor's liberal interpretations any person interested in the historical narrative of David and his times would benefit by reading this absorbing book.

The author postulated many ideas that bear reflecting on. His presentation of background on the historical period of David and the cultural mores of the time is both informational and intriguing. This book will deserve a 'return visit' to savor more closely.

I liked how the author provided a critical analysis of the Bible but still retained his reverence and respect for its teachings. Although I would have liked to see more emphasis on actual historical facts, overall I felt like I learned a lot more about not only David, but the authors of his story as well, without feeling like my faith had been diminished or attacked (as can often happen with books in this

genre).
