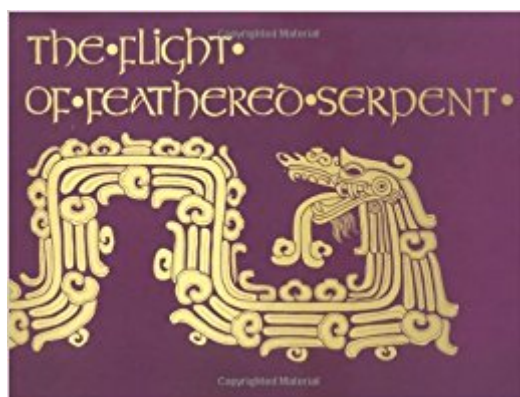

Some of the schools of thought in this book are a bit outdated (you can tell it has a rather 70's-ish vibe to it..... especially the whole section about sex that seems to come out of nowhere, haha!), but in order to read the cards it was meant to accompany, this book is vital. The second half is a page focused on each individual card and all the info you'd need to read them. It also shows the journey of the fool through the tarot. I don't particularly like the format of the physical book, though it is probably my pickiness. It is a very wide book as you can tell from the picture, so it won't fit a book shelf well at all. Compared to every other tarot book I have it sticks out an extra 5 inches or so... This makes reading it a little daunting because of the way the text has to be formatted in columns. The pictures on a lot of the pages do help though. For anyone NOT studying design though, this is a good book and I would say mandatory for anyone who gets the Xultun Tarot.

This book was written a long time ago and some of the calendar information isn't quite right, but it's an interesting view of how the Maya's calendar and culture was viewed in the past. The Xultun Tarot (sold separately) isn't required for you to learn from the book, but if you buy the deck, you DO need the book too!
