This sounded like a fun read and it did turn out to be OK for the 20% I did read. It is collection of very short tales about so-called haunted places (and as with anything on this subject, it is mostly local legend, hearsay, and folksy story telling.) I finally had to stop, because when subject/verb tenses do not match I spend more time focusing on that after I find several, than I do on reading. Even a good friend of the author's who is talented at English language could probably clean this up nicely and make it more of a "clean read."

I enjoyed this book very much; the formatting made it easy to read yet easy to put down if I

absolutely had to, to do something like eat, sleep, etc. :) There were a few minor grammar errors and the Riker's Island pages are repeated near the end, but that didn't stop me enjoying the entries. More, please!

As Dragnet's Sgt. Friday always said "Just the facts" and with each installment of the ghost tales in this book, I was reminded of that phrase. The content was interesting especially when I read about places I'd been to but it was told in a very dry, matter of fact way that grated on my nerves after a while. Histories were given of the places but no emotions or "juicy" details were included in the tales. I'm glad I borrowed it for free with Prime because I don't think it's worth \$ 9.99 to buy it.
