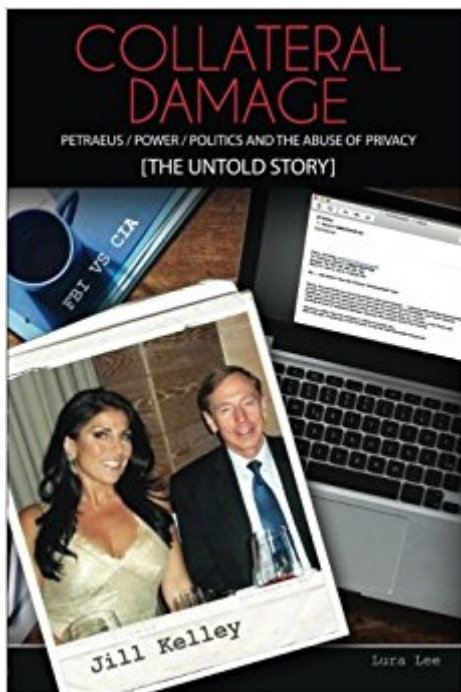

Jill Kelley is an advocate, activist and author on electronic privacy rights. Prior to her book, Kelley was at the epicenter of the political scandal that led to the tumultuous resignation of retired general and CIA director David Petraeus and General John Allen Åçâ –â œ during unprecedented time of havoc in AmericaÅçâ –â œs war against terrorism. Kelley's infamous story gives testament to the abuse that Snowden warns about. Her story exemplifies the harms and collateral damage that can caused when government officials abuse their power, prying into the private emails and photos of a law abiding citizens, causing one of the greatest political scandals in recent history. Since then, Kelley has become an internet privacy expert.
