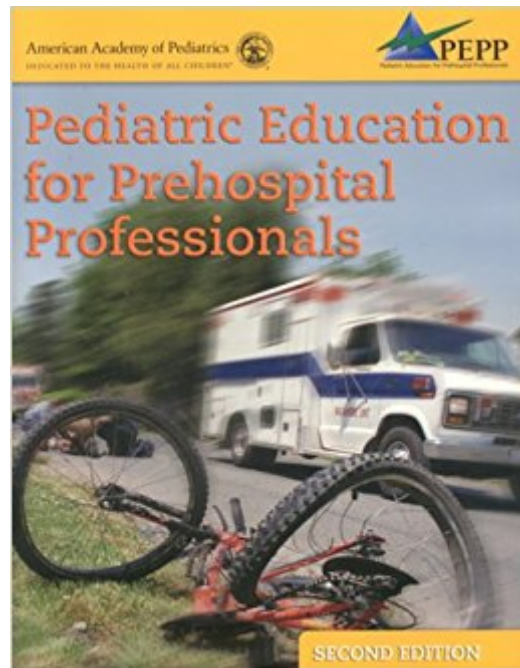




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# Pediatric Education For Prehospital Professionals (PEPP), Second Edition

He is the Editor-in-Chief of several of the parent publications for the AAP including "Caring For Your Baby" and "Young Child, The First Year Of Life," and "A Guide to Child Symptoms," Dr. Shelov pioneered and developed these series of books.
