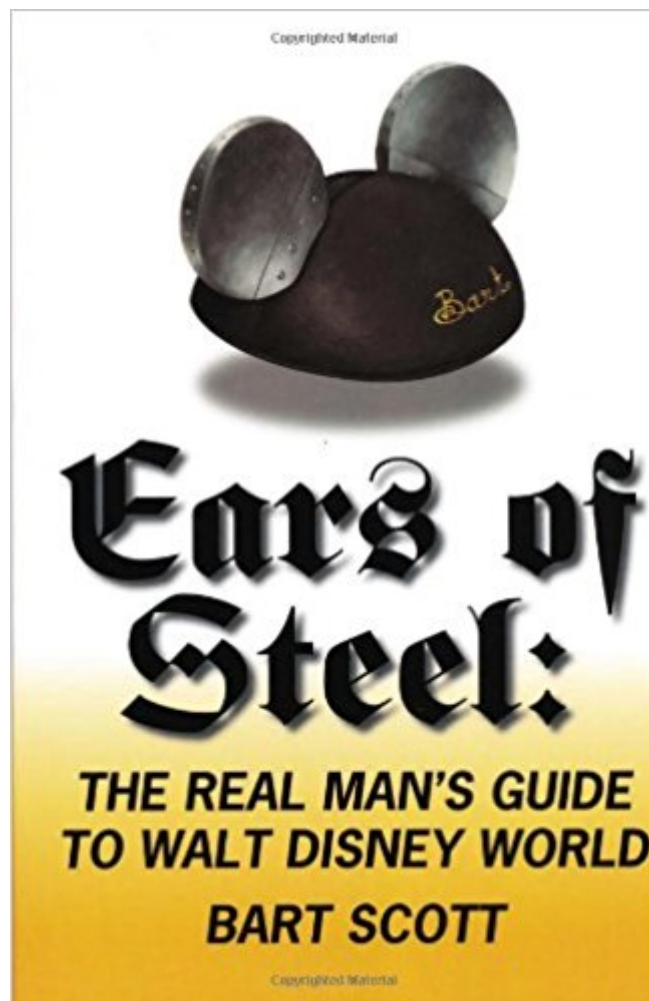




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Ears Of Steel: The Real Man's Guide To Walt Disney World
