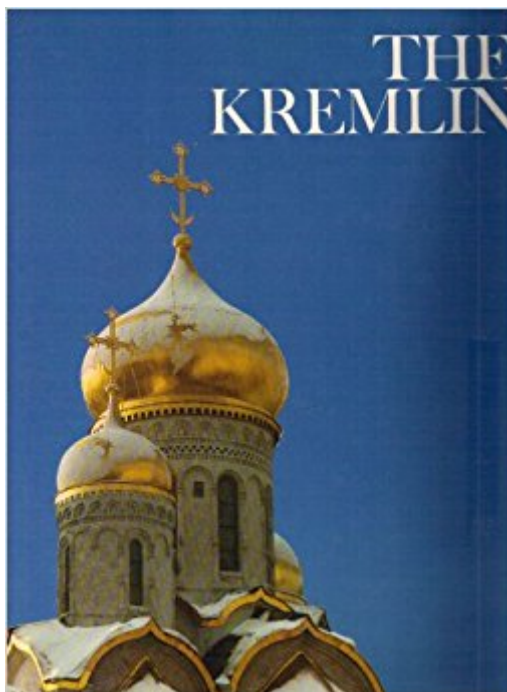

If you can take the historical content in this book with a grain of salt, it's a fantastic book for the coffee table. Despite an anti-Russian bias (written in the West during the Soviet "cold war" period, of course) the book is worth the price for the full-colour photos alone. There are several Orthodox icons, and wonderful snapshots of the St. Basil Cathedral and the surrounding Kremlin. There is a lot of good information here too, about the history of the Kremlin. If you already know something about Russian history, pick this one up. I found it at a Goodwill store, and like it so much I bought this copy for my friend. If you are American, go ahead and feel free to compare Washington to the Kremlin - doesn't hold a candle to it.

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
