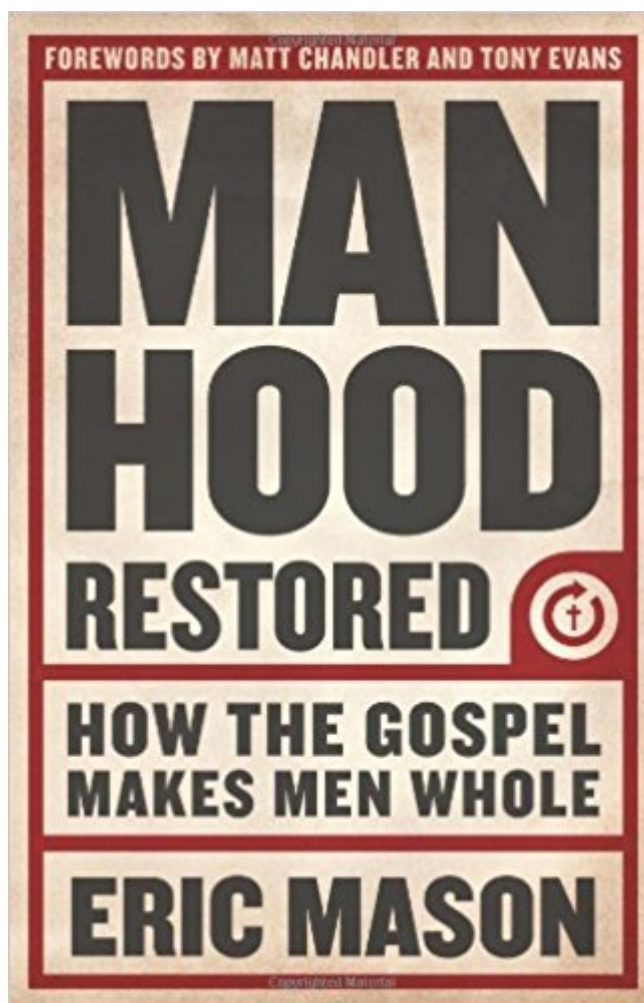

Manhood Restored: How The Gospel Makes Men Whole



Synopsis

The earthly crisis within manhood will be there until Jesus returns, but in Christ men are pointed toward the gospel as the vision for renewal. Manhood Restored by exciting new pastoral voice Eric Mason combines theological depth with practical insights, putting men in step with a gospel-centered manhood that will enrich every facet of their lives. Mason begins with The Scope of Manhood -- looking first at why God created man, at the divine differences between man and woman, and what should drive the purpose of a man during his time on earth. A section on The Problems in Manhood analyzes the false icons that lead to cultural caricatures of men -- the businessman, the thug, the playboy, the athlete, etc. Mason then makes a connection to the cross-cultural fatherhood crisis, looking at the things men do to fill the void when their relationship with dad or God is not there. Finally, The Redemption of Manhood sets Jesus as the true standard of biblical manhood, looking to his perfect example to redeem and restore a man's life in the areas of sexuality, home, and work.

A good book where the Gospel is central. Christ is central in this book, and that is applauded. He has something to say, and when he says it, it works. Sometimes, however, he doesn't quite make his point. I don't personally enjoy Mason's tangents and personal stories peppered throughout the work--not because of them being tangents, but because I find they only loosely relate to the big picture. Sometimes points are clearly defined in the book--I had some issues with chapters 2 and 4 in particular. However, it is a good book to read with a small group as it can potentially bring up some good issues for men to discuss.

Mason takes readers into the passages and puts you into contact with the Scriptures. This is a great thing. This is the best book on Biblical manhood that I have read, thus far. It is a book you will want to have your Bible at hand with...The author has packed so many passages in, that you will want to go to the Scriptures and find out more for yourself. I found that God challenged me in ways I have not been challenged before--I realize it is only because of Mason's reliance upon God and the Spirit's use of the Bible in the book. I'm not a book worshiper--although, this review may seem like that. My admonition to all who read books outside of the Bible is to make sure you go back and look up all the Scriptures and read for yourself, so that you are directly exhorted by God's Word. I believe God will use this book in many lives of the men who read it and desire to move with God's Spirit to true Biblical manhood. Lastly, I bought multiple copies and gave them away to many of the young men and men I am around on a regular basis. I thought, and still think, that the message presented in the book is right on the mark and will aid in the instruction of men in the faith.

The main proposition of this book is that the Gospel, the good news that Jesus Christ gave His own life to save sinners, restores and is restoring men back to true manhood. Mason does an exceedingly biblical job of showing the problematic consequences of what happens with the gospel is absent in a society and a son. He then goes on to show what gospel-centered manhood looks like in key areas like marriage, fatherhood, culture, and church. An excellent book for all men.

Eric Mason has done a huge service for men with this book. I personally have grown tired of a

number of books in this genre, which are more about chest-thumping and aligning with cultural views of manliness. Mason is having none of that. *Manhood Restored* goes to great lengths to lay out a biblical idea of true, Christ-honoring manhood. My quibbles with it: My Kindle version has some obvious typos, which I found a bit distracting. Not sure why they didn't get edited out. At times it's not written in the most engaging manner. There is nothing doctrinally I have issues with, and I still commend this book to you.

At a time where manhood needs to be restored in the lives of young men, Eric Mason of Epiphany Fellowship delivers with his book. He sees the lives of young men damaged by a lack of fathers and father-figures while living in a culture dominated by sex, drugs and violence. He correctly points this to the fall of man and because of Adam's sin, men's actions have only become more deviant today. He points out how young boys have suffered from daddy deprivation, therefore struggling with finding their true identity. Not to mention how boys look to the businessman, the thug, the playboy and athlete to fill the void left by the father. He uses scripture and pragmatic examples of how to restore manhood, while also pointing to Jesus as the one who men should model themselves after. It is only through following Jesus that real men can be restored not only in the church, but in their families.

I recently lost a relationship to a beautiful Christian girl mostly due to my lack of Biblical maturity. She had more Biblical knowledge than me and several times mentioned that she wants a spiritual leader. I didn't understand. In this world of equal rights and responsibility I had come to accept that most women want a spiritual partner rather than a leader. One of my favorite quotes in this book is that that God intended the chain of command to be God, Jesus, man, woman, creatures. If we are believers than we need to strive to maintain the order that God intended and to nurture and build our woman's growth and happiness in all areas of life. It also inspired me to become a better Christian man and understand that Jesus truly was a man's man rather than an effeminate man as he is typically portrayed. This book is an easy read and very inspiring.

The book is a little hard to follow in places. The chapter on "Restored Vision" is particularly difficult. The material is not hard or "deep," but the organization of it is not clear. I did enjoy reading the book. There are some valuable lessons on being a godly man. I think Mason does a fair job. I would recommend it if you want another (fresh) perspective on biblical manhood.

I thought Mr. Mason hit the nail on the head in this book. With a society that is so influenced by feminism and a culture that has degraded masculinity to the length of a man's beard or the type of alcohol he drinks, this book is a power reminder of how God defines masculinity. Mr. Mason consistently addresses Jesus as the ultimate man and corrects many of the cliché-ed thoughts concerning Him. Personally, I appreciated this book because Mr. Mason points out that men have serious flaws, but he also points out Biblical solutions to these flaws. Every man needs to read this book and let it challenge his life to be more like Jesus.

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
