

I have a few knot books, but I like the selection in this book the best. It is a good sailor's reference. It covers whippings and splicings and is very well organized. It doesn't go into a lot of theory or history. "Why Knot?" is a good one for that.

I also did not care for the hand drawn rope example images, this book would have been immensely better if they showed actual pictures.
