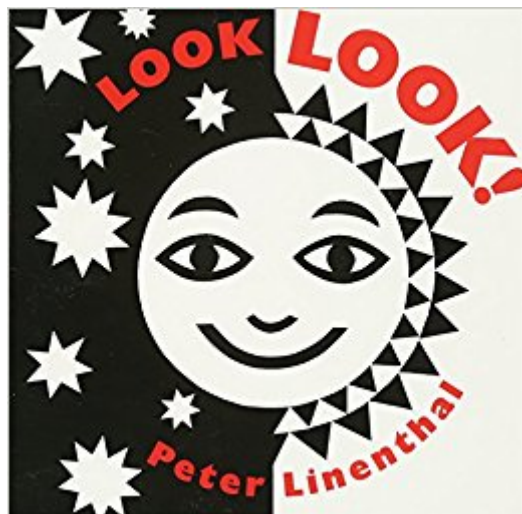

This has been our baby's favorite book from the very beginning. He loves this book. You open it up and he'll stop crying and start checking out the book. The words are very basic (like two words basic), so it's more for a baby who is looking and not for one who needs a story or a lot of words. We started reading it around 2 or 3 months.
