

After serving in the US Army, he attended Northern Illinois University and worked in Chicago for several years as a corporate writer. He now lives with his wife and two sons in Champaign-Urbana, where he teaches writing and literature at the University of Illinois. His novel, *A Democracy of Ghosts*, is set during the infamous Herrin Massacre and its main character is based on Griswoldâ™s grandfather, who was a state senator and the UMWA sub-district president in Herrin in 1922.
