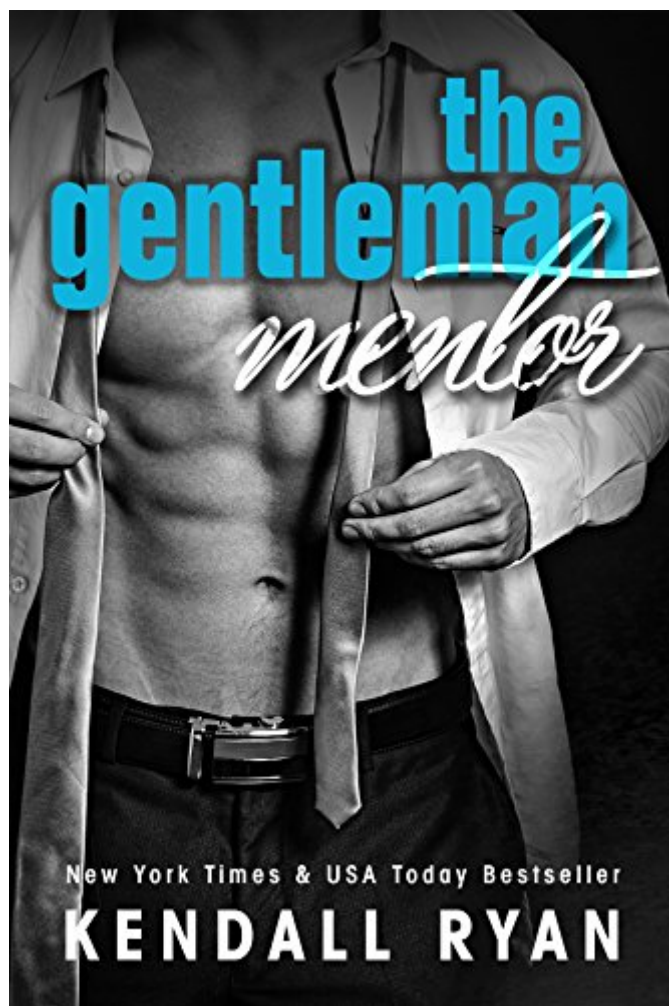

I loved the overall premise of the story, with Brielle reaching out to the Gentleman Mentor because she needs help with ramping up her sexual image and experience so she can attract the attention of her best male friend Kirby in order to move out of the friend zone. Hale, the Gentleman Mentor, is a Dom and while Brielle doesn't see her submissive nature, Hale most certainly does. Their arrangement benefits the both of them, Brielle will learn to be a seductress and Hale can mentor only long enough to avoid forming any attachment. At least he plans to do that for Brielle's benefit, it is certainly not his intent to fall for her or anyone. They had fantastic chemistry. I could see the transformation in Brielle from someone who is shy and insecure to someone more confident and aware with each encounter. I liked both Hale and Brielle. Even though Hale has a dominant nature, it never came off as overbearing, and at times, he seemed a lot gentler than I expected. He also became emotionally invested a lot faster than I had anticipated, too, even if he wasn't showing it to Brielle, but she could feel it. Will Brielle use her new skill set to attract her friend or does she and

Hale have something worth pursuing? Would Hale let Brielle into his life when he has already sworn that he wouldn't with another woman? Although the story didn't feel fast paced, it does move fast based on the timeline. Good read overall.

When I first read the synopsis for Kendall Ryan's *The Gentleman Mentor* I was so intrigued.
