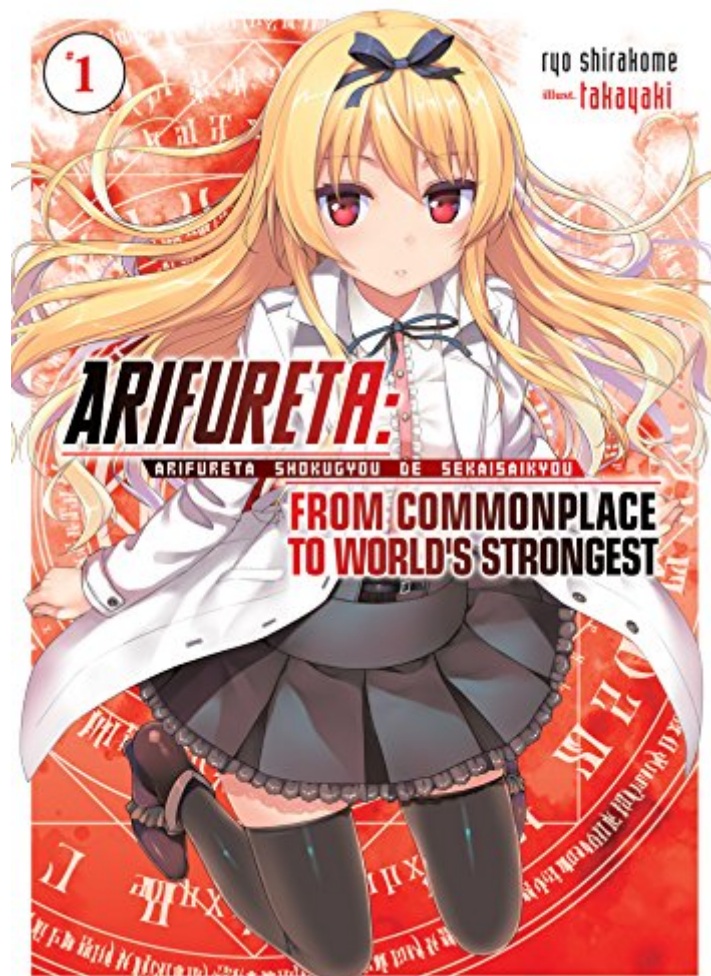

I waver between liking it and thinking its just OK. This book employs the currently popular "Protagonist summoned to a fantasy world to be a hero" story line. Where it differs is that the protagonist is summoned with his entire high school class. Already an outcast among his fellow students because of his hobbies and being the object of infatuation of the class idol, the gulf is widened further when his classmates receive incredibly rare and powerful abilities and all he can do

is a common blacksmith skill. Then after a horrible accident in the dungeon he is believed dead but is in fact going through a harrowing adventure that will make him the strongest. Well the characters were nice in that it gives you valid reason to dislike most of the classmates and feel sympathetic to the protagonist. As was the description of the suffering the protagonist has to go through when he is on his own. One thing I am not so keen on was the dungeon or the power scaling. In some ways the dungeon gives the reader a means by which to understand just how "strong" people in this fantasy world can be, explaining that no one had yet to clear a specific floor. Yet when the dungeon's origins are explained you come to realize that there is a power gap so far beyond humans, that I am a little concerned the author is going to write himself into a corner trying to think of new legitimate threats. Or maybe the the readers are supposed to derive enjoyment from seeing the interactions between this once mocked now OP character and the people that once tormented him but now are little more than ants compared to him?

I have read a few light novels and watched a lot of anime and I absolutely loved this novel. I saw it in my suggestions section after reading a few others similar to it and when I read the premise of the book thought it sounded a little generic, after reading a review by Ryan Monahan, I decided to buy it because it sounded exactly like something I would enjoy. I must say I was not disappointed at all! I enjoy pretty much all of the "transported to another world" genre of stories or at least I haven't found one I have disliked yet. This one is a bit different. Instead of just the protagonist getting transported his whole class does. It starts out with him just getting bullied and it goes from bad to worse and eventually takes a dark turn, he goes through hell before it gets any better for him but there is a ray of hope in the proverbial hell he is out through. As he gets stronger the story just gets better and better. I can not wait for the next volume in this series as I believe it will continue to build on an already great first volume and make you want to continue this journey with Hajime in this other world!

The story was interesting, but the length of it left much to be desired. I can understand why people try to find these things online and not actually purchase them. For the cost of these stories and how little there is to read it is understandable that people try not to spend that money on something that will give them enjoyment for such a small time. Don't get me wrong. The story was funny and interesting, but it's like 150 pages. That's shorter than those cruddy smut novels that ladies crank out several times a year.

I was very surprised by how much I enjoyed this book. I've tried reading a few LNs and they always seem shallow and totally lacking in conflict; not so here. While a lot of the plot is pretty shallow, it's more than made up for with the characters and the near constant conflict.

This is a light novel full of unique lovable characters and a very well thought out story line to back it up.

Don't bother trying to read the poorly translated web series or light novels; they will just give you a headache. The official english translation of this series is far superior to what you'll find on the net that's been fan-translated. The series isn't amazing, but I enjoyed my time with it and will pick up the next book when it comes out.

This is a very good, well written, and entertaining book. There are a lot of stories out there of the same genre, but this one incorporates a new twist to the mix. The fact that the main character loses a bit of his humanity. The character development is amazing. And I feel that the plot is solid enough. This has a great mix of seriousness and fun. It is one of those books that you will go and read in one sitting because the story and the way it's written just grips you.
