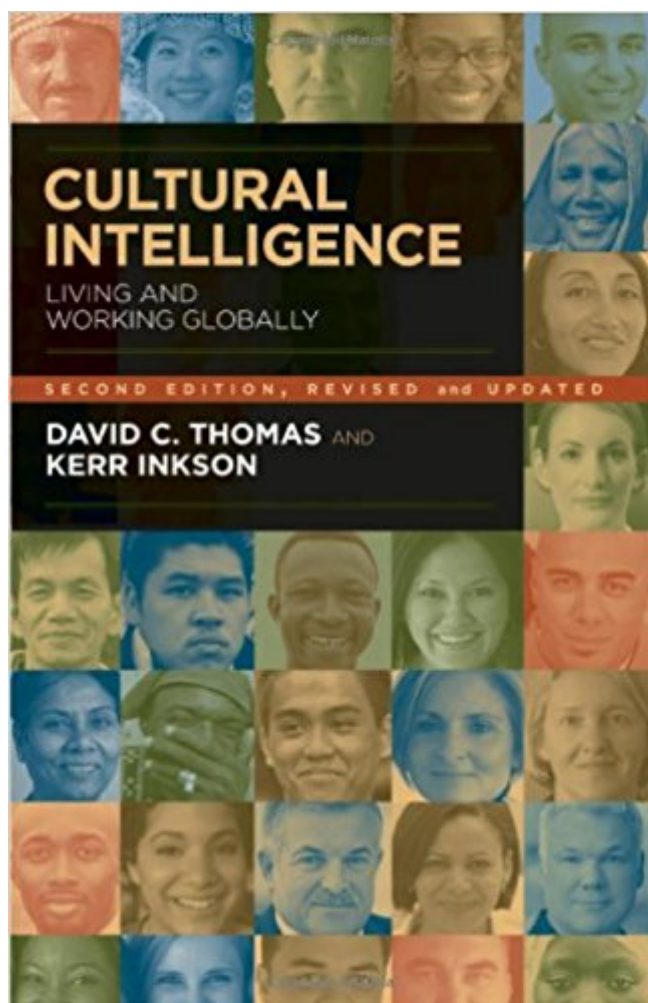

His research on the interaction of individuals from different cultures in organizational settings has prompted him to conduct studies in more than a dozen different countries. Kerr Inkson is Professor of Management at the University of Otago, New Zealand. He is a member of the Editorial Board of Journal of Organizational Behavior and a Distinguished Member of the Australian and New Zealand Academy of Management, and a former winner of the Best International Paper award of the Academy of Management.

The book provides a clear description of contemporary comparative theories of culture, and suggests how to apply them in practice. This is an excellent guideline for those who travel and work abroad, and also for those who interact with people from other cultures in her/his home environment. It helps to look from aside to one's own culture and , as much as possible' to take in account and avoid biases often typical for unprepared ones who interact with other cultures. On the other and, it must be taken in account that the authors represent quite similar, anglo-saxon based cultures, so the level of their cultural neutrality might be not excellent. It would be interesting to see in the future a similar book written by the team representing more different cultures.
