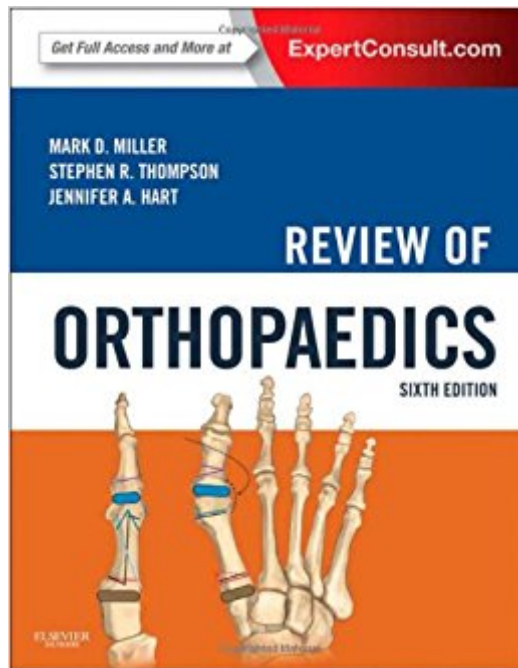

Great overall reference for orthopaedics. The level of detail is good enough for most things required and for studying for boards. However, for more in depth information, I would recommend Rockwood and/or Campbells. The hand sections are okay but leave a lot to be desired Also, the pathology section is reasonable although the differentiation between of certain disorders/conditions is not always clear. Overall, I would highly recommend this text as a good review of overall orthopedics, especially when learning the basics or as a quick reference; however, it is not meant to be an exhaustive reference by any means. I would also be sure to get the most up to date copy as this version does differ from previous editions. Compared to the prior editions, the presentation of material is much better in regards to charts/images/tables.
